**2007-2008 Estacada School District Report Card**

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- Grades 4, 5, 6, 7, and 10 scored above the state averages in RLA
- Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 scored above the state averages in MA
- Grades 5, 8, and 10 scored above the state averages in SC

**Other Highlights:**

- As a District, “Test Participation” increased as compared to the prior year
- As a District, “Attendance” increased as compared to the prior year
- As a District, “Classes Taught by Highly Qualified Teachers” (95.3%) exceeds the State average of 91.7%

**Other Points of Interest:**

- Grades 4, 7, and 10 declined in Writing; however, statewide averages also declined at each grade level
- Estacada School District Staffing decreased by 10.1
- SPED and ESL populations increased slightly; SPED also increased at the State level while the ESL population remained the same
- Special Education serves 17.4% of our student population; the State average is 14.5%
- ESL programs serve 7.4% of our student population; the State average is 10.0%

**Financial Data:**

- ESD support dropped by \$28.00 per student from the prior year (06-07)

**General Fund Expenditures:**

- Estacada School District’s General Fund Expenditures dropped by \$487. per student from 06-07 (07-08 \$6774. per student; 06-07 \$7261. per student)
- Direct Classroom Support decreased by \$204. per student
- Classroom Support decreased by 169. per student
- Building Support decreased by \$91. per student
- Central Support decreased by \$23. per student

**Clackamas River Elementary School Report Card:**

- 06-07 Overall Rating: Strong – 3.0 (Refer to “Overall Rating” chart on page 5)
- 07-08 Overall Rating: Strong – 3.0
- Student enrollment decreased by 35 from prior year
- 06-07 Staffing: 34.4
- 07-08 Staffing: 31.1
- Improved “Attendance” over prior year
- Improved “Test Participation” over prior year

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in RLA
- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in MA (CRE was below the averages for these three comparisons in 06-07)
- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in WR
- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools and the State in SC

**Improvement Rating (Assessments and Attendance):**

- CRE remained at “Stayed About the Same” (scored -0.1 in 07-08; 3.9 in 06-07; refer to “Improvement Ratings” Chart on page 5)

**Eagle Creek Elementary School Report Card:**

- 06-07 Overall Rating: Satisfactory – 2.8
- 07-08 Overall Rating: Satisfactory – 2.8
- Student enrollment decreased by 16 from prior year
- 06-07 Staffing: 36.5
- 07-08 Staffing: 36.0
- ESL population increased by 2.6%
- # of classes with 26-30 students increased by 3 (2 in 06-07; 5 in 07-08)
- ECE slightly improved “Attendance”

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in RLA
- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in MA (was below the State average in 06-07)
- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in WR (was below the District and State averages in 06-07)
- Scored above the averages for Comparison Schools, District, and State in SC

**Improvement Rating (Assessments and Attendance):**

- ECE remained at “Stayed About the Same” (scored -0.7 in 07-08; -2.9 in 06-07)

**River Mill Elementary School Report Card:**

- 06-07 Overall Rating: Strong – 3.0
- 07-08 Overall Rating: Satisfactory – 2.2
- Student enrollment increased by 20 from prior year
- 06-07 Staffing: 33.9
- 07-08 Staffing: 37.7
- ESL population decreased by .5%
- RME slightly decreased “Attendance” (.4%)
- RME slightly decreased “Test Participation” (.1%)

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- Scored the same as the averages for Comparison Schools, lower than the District and State averages in RLA (was below the averages for all three comparison groups in 06-07)
- Scored the same as Comparison Schools, lower than the District and State averages in MA (was above all three comparison groups in 06-07)
- Scored above Comparison Schools, lower than District and State averages in WR (was below all three comparison groups in 06-07)
- Scored above the Comparison Schools and State averages in SC

**Improvement Rating (Assessments and Attendance):**

- RME remained at “Stayed About the Same” (scored -1.3 in 07-08; 2.1 in 06-07)

**Estacada Junior High School Report Card:**

- 06-07 Overall Rating: Strong – 3.8
- 07-08 Overall Rating: Satisfactory – 2.0
- Student enrollment decreased by 4 from prior year
- 06-07 Staffing: 37.8
- 07-08 Staffing: 34.9
- Improved percentage of “Highly Qualified Teachers” from 85.6% to 100%
- ESL population decreased by 1.3%
- EJHS increased “Attendance”
- EJHS increased “Test Participation”

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- Scored above the averages of the Comparison Schools and the District, while the same as the State in RLA
- Scored above the averages of the Comparison Schools and the District, while below the State average in MA (was above all three comparison groups in 06-07)
- Scored below the averages of the Comparison Schools and the State in WR (was above all three comparison groups in 06-07)
- Scored above the Comparison Schools, District, and State averages in SC

**Improvement Rating (Assessments and Attendance):**

- 06-07: “Improved” (highest rating given by State) {10.9 in 06-07}
- 07-08: “Stayed About the Same” {2.5 in 07-08}

**Estacada High School Report Card:**

- 06-07 Overall Rating: Satisfactory – 1.8
- 07-08 Overall Rating: Satisfactory – 2.0
- Student enrollment decreased by 21 from prior year
- 06-07 Staffing: 71.8
- 07-08 Staffing: 70.6

- ESL population increased 1.2%
- EHS increased “Attendance” by 1.8%
- EHS increased “Test Participation” by 1.9%
- Reduced the number of expulsions due to weapons
- Dropout rate (3.4%) is below the District (14.8%) and State averages (4.3%)

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- Scored equal to the averages of the Comparison Schools, and District, and above the State average for RLA (was below the Comparison Schools by 11% and State by 12% in 06-07)
- Decreased the margin of percentage scored below the Comparison Schools to 1% and the State to 3% as compared to 06-07 when EHS was 5% below the Comparison Schools and 6% below the State average in MA
- Scored below the averages of the Comparison Schools and the State averages in WR
- Scored above the averages for the Comparison Schools, District, and State in SC

**Improvement Rating (Assessments, Attendance, and Dropout):**

- Moved from a “Declined” rating (-6.3) in 06-07 to “Stayed About the Same” (-0.4) in 07-08

**Estacada Alternative High School Report Card:**

- 06-07 Overall Rating: Not Rated (1<sup>st</sup> year of data)
- 07-08 Overall Rating: Not Rated (2<sup>nd</sup> year of data)
- Met “AYP” by submitting additional data; RC does not collect additional data in order to designate a rating
- Student enrollment decreased by 11 from prior year
- 06-07 Staffing: 15.1
- 07-08 Staffing: 11.7
- ESL population increased by 2.7%
- EAHS increased “Attendance”
- EAHS increased “Test Participation” from 85.4% (Unacceptable) in 06-07 to 100% (Exceptional) in 07-08
- *Not enough years of data for dropout rating to be applied; dropout data lags behind the assessment data by one year; the RC does display the 06-07 dropout rate at 23%*

**Academic Achievement (Percentage of Students Meeting Standards):**

- *Too few students (less than 6) to display academic achievement*

**Improvement Rating (Assessments, Attendance, and Dropout):**

- EAHS did not receive an “Improvement Rating” as they lack the required number of 80 tests and or 50 students in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade attending in the last two years combined.
