Dear Eagle Creek Families,

Thursday, February 2, marks the end of the second quarter (as well as the first semester.) Therefore, **students will not have school on Friday, February 3**, as it will be a day for teachers to work on report cards. Report cards are generally sent home the Friday the following week unless there are technical difficulties that require additional time. This would put report cards in your hands on Friday, February 10th. Mark your calendars for Awards Assemblies the morning of Friday, February 17th: 9:30 (1-3) and 10:30 (4-6). The office will inform you if your child will be receiving an award on this date.

The District has implemented a new automatic calling system to call parents on inclement weather days. Did you receive a phone call on Jan. 17th when we had a two-hour snow delay or and on Jan. 18th when we had no school? If you did not, please contact the school office and provide your current phone number. We will provide this number to the district so you should receive future calls. Thank you!

The school calendar for the year put two snow days into the calendar. In the event of a snow day, school will be extended for a day. Now that we have had this snow day, the NEW last student day for students is June 13. Keep in mind that if we have another school closure, the last day of school might be extended again.
